Camp Descriptions: Age 2½ through Age 12

Sessions will be age appropriate for each group and geared to their level of learning.

Week One: Ready to Travel

Get that passport and pack your suitcase as we prepare to travel the globe. Students will make their own passport and discuss ways of travel as they get ready for their summer adventure.

Weeks Two/Three: China

Join the panda and stroll along the Great Wall of China as we learn about the Chinese people and their unique culture and rich history. Look for some pearls and jade along the way and see what other treasures you can find.

Week Four: America

Wear your red, white and blue and bring your flag. In honor of the Fourth of July, we will focus on the birth of our Nation and America's rich history.

Weeks Five/Six: Brazil

Join the toucan as travelers cruise down the Amazon River and explore the rain forest of Brazil. The hot steamy weather of July will feel just like we are entering the rain forest. Keep a look out for those red eyed tree frogs.

Weeks Seven/Eight: Russia

Take a trip with the nesting dolls through the amazing buildings and palaces of Russia. Learn about the famous artists, writers and ballet dancers as their culture and rich history is explored.

Weeks Nine/Ten: Australia

Take a walk about with the kangaroo as students are welcomed to the world down under. Set your sights on the beautiful landscape and hope you do not run into a Croc.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Age 2½ through Age 12

Welcome to the Winchester Academy summer program where all students get to enjoy a summer filled with cultural arts, creativity, and physical fitness! Winchester Academy ensures that all staff is screened and background checks, along with training in First Aid and CPR. Our incredible staff look forward to an amazing summer and we know your children are going to love the enrichment opportunities. Come for a week or come all summer! See below for all the details and fill out the registration form and send it in to reserve your spot.

Enrollment

Complete the enclosed registration form and mail to Winchester Academy, 915 S. Cameron Street, Winchester, VA 22601. A registration fee of \$50 is required in order to hold your spot. This will be applied to your summer tuition once a contract has been received. Questions about the program should be directed to Tina Heironimus, Administrator at theironimus@winchesteracademy.org.

Financial Requirements

A confirmation for registered weeks of camp, a welcome packet, your payment invoice and a contract which will need to be signed and returned will be forwarded to the address provided. Invoices are mailed and payment is expected within 15 days of the invoice date. Payment for weekly camps is due at the time of registration. Payment plans for all summer tuition are offered but there is an additional \$30.00 processing fee, which is due at the start of the summer. Parents choosing a monthly payment plan would need to contact Trone Kee at tkee@winchesteracademy.org for payment dates.

Financial Aid

Aid is available for qualifying families. Parents interested in receiving aid need to apply online at www.factstuitionaid.com and all fees are the responsibility of the parent. Typically, combined incomes of more than \$50,000 are not eligible to receive aid.

Clubhouse: Sessions 12:00-4:00 pm

After each morning class finishes, there will be special programming available to our students. Weekly after camp programs will have exposure to the cultural arts through dance, theatre, guest speakers, visual and performing arts, music, local tours and even opportunities to go to the local swimming pools. The announcement of those after camp experiences will be given to the students at the start of the summer and will be adjusted as the programs are released so others can sign up. Those classes will be offered in the afternoons from 12- 4 pm. Students who are in the full-day program are automatically enrolled.

Meal Plan

For students who stay in the program from 12:00pm – 6:00 pm, catered lunches are provided for any student at a cost of \$3.65 per day which includes a drink. Ala cart snacks and drinks will be available for purchase. Students who qualify for the free USDA breakfast/lunch/snack program will be provided with a meal plan included in the cost of the tuition. Parents wishing to apply for this program should contact the school for the proper forms.

Friend Referral

Parents who recommend our program to new parents, and register their child by the start of the summer program, will receive a \$50 credit towards their tuition for their referral, which will be applied in the last month of camp. In order to qualify their “friend” must sign their payment contract before the discount will be applied.

Pool Days

Weather permitting; students will have a weekly visit to a local public pool on a designated day after the morning camps are finished. Those students not interested in attending the pool day will have an alternate activity. The cost of the admittance to the pool is the responsibility of the parent. Pool passes are encouraged. In order to attend the pool the student must be seven (7) years old. Students not traveling to the pool and students under seven will also have designated water days on the campus playgrounds weekly.

Student Life

Students are given the opportunity to socialize, which is an important part of the development and interest of elementary and middle school students. Breaks are provided in the camps and socialization is encouraged!

Medical Requirements

Students who have specific medical needs must meet with our medical officials to determine acceptance into the program. WA is able to address most medical needs, but will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Tutoring

Hourly Rate Tutoring at \$35 and is available by appointment for individual academic needs and advancement opportunities in all subject areas and all grades. Call to make your tutoring arrangements.
